

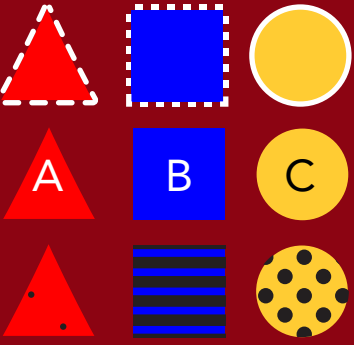

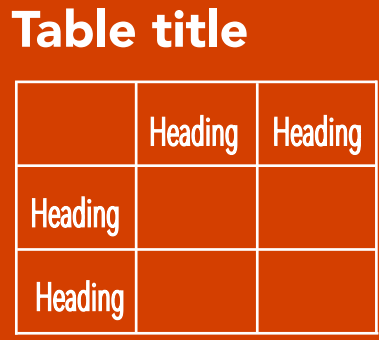


Accessibility Basics for Instructors - design with accessibility in mind

FONTS	<p>Use simple fonts with good spacing and sufficient weight for best readability. Avoid overly stylized or thin fonts.</p>	 <p>AaBbCc AaBbCc</p>									
CONTRAST	<p>Ensure sufficient contrast between text and background, including text on images. Add a contrast checker to your browser.</p>	 <p>too low good</p>									
COLOR	<p>Use shapes, symbols, line decoration or pattern. Include alt text for icons. Avoid using color as the sole way to convey meaning.</p>										
IMAGES	<p>Include Alt tags for all images and icons. Add full description and copyright info below image. Avoid using images solely for decoration.</p>	 <p>alt="description" image description</p>									
LINKS	<p>Use descriptive link text and ensure links are underlined. Include descriptive link text for image and icon links. Avoid "Click Here" links with no description.</p>	 <p>Topic Information</p>									
TABLES	<p>Use formatted headers for columns and/or rows. Avoid tables for non-tabular data or layout. 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VIDEO	<p>Provide captioning or transcript of audio. Videos should have player controls to pause, stop, and restart.</p>	 <p>Week 1 Video Transcript link</p>
